The COVID-19 pandemic has presented us with unprecedented challenges in the way we operate at Flinthills Services. Our Life Skills and production programs closed on March 17, 2020. since then, clients living in out group homes have observed stay-at-home practices, and clients living at other agencies or with their families have had to adapt not attending Flinthills ever day for socialization and skill building.

The "new normal" for some businesses includes allowing employees to work remotely or to change their hours of operation. Yet, for those working as Direct Support Professionals, working from home is not an option. Direct support for persons with developmental disabilities cannot be done remotely, through a drive-through, or curbside delivery. Direct Support Professionals come to work everyday to support our clients during this crisis and beyond. They are on the front lines, every bit as much as healthcare workers and first responders. They come to work knowing their clients depend on them, all while dealing with their own health concerns, financial worries and concerns for their own families.
